

English Spelling

All contestants are to abide by the dress codes for Regional Student Convention.

English Spelling is carried out in correspondence form. All participants in this event will receive an audio file with a dictation record and an answer form through e-mail and/or various instant messengers (Viber, Whatsapp).

The answer form must be printed.

The day of English Spelling will be announced later. The organizers will set the beginning time for English Spelling.

The judge will pronounce each word twice and give a definition for the word. Contestants will write the word. Each contestant will write all words.

No later than 10 minutes after the time announced by the organizers of the end of the Spelling, each participant must send a scan or photo of his work to the e-mail address nvladimir@mail.ru or to various messengers (Viber, WhatsApp).

The answer form sent after this time is not accepted or evaluated.

Winners will be selected according to accuracy. Judges shall give at least two practice words before starting competition.

Words are provided by A.C.E. and must be spelled exactly as they appear in Word Building PACEs.

Alternate or British spellings will not be allowed. A.C.E.'s list is compiled from the preferred spelling found in Scott Foresman, Thorndike Barnhart Advanced Dictionary.

Word Building words are used for English Spelling:

- 8-9 years old: Levels 2-4;
- 10-12 years old: Levels 5-7;
- 13-18 years old: Level 7 and above.
